# What are Community Groups? B.A.S.E.

**B** **Bible Study.** Groups will engage in discussion and life transforming studies that connect the Bible with your life story. Studies involve members in interactive conversations with easy to follow discussion guides and lessons. Groups meet anytime and anywhere such as in homes, coffee shops, school, and work.

**A** **Authentic Relationships.** In your group you can develop authentic, transparent relationships with others by living a deeper Christian life together. Community! God made us for being with each other in community. Deep relationships grow as you study together, have fun together, and serve together.

**S** **Service.** In your group, you will serve each other and your community by performing simple acts of service. These acts can be as simple as shoveling snow, planting flowers at a school, or visiting a nursing home. Opportunities are unlimited. 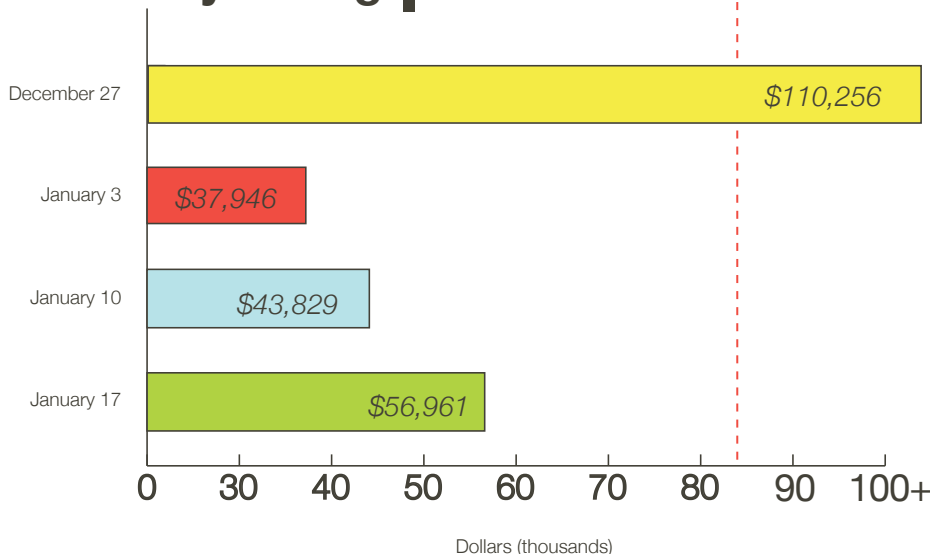

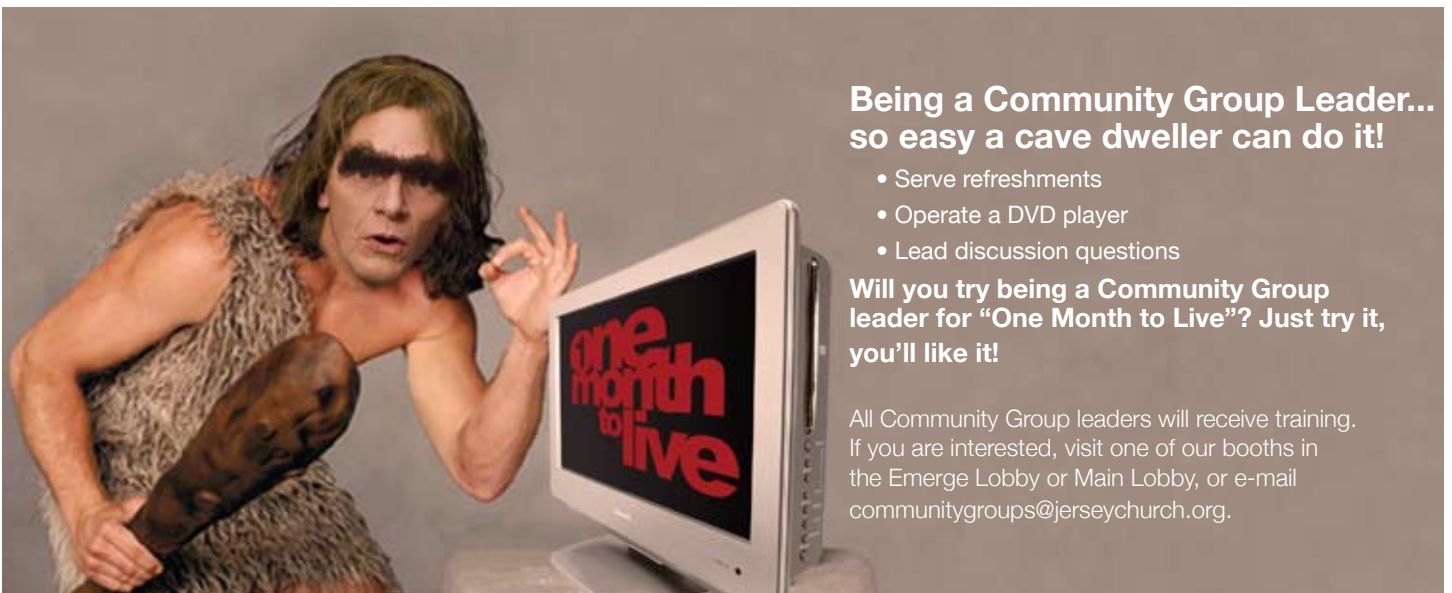

### Soup Kitchen at Stowe Center

Maxine Burns has served food at the Soup Kitchen at the Stowe Center for 19 incredible years. She started serving meals in 1991. In the early years of serving at Stowe, they would serve about 50 people on the second Monday of each month. As the years went on, the numbers served continued to grow. Today, they serve between 170 – 200 meals on a Monday. Maxine has a group of 4 or 5 volunteers who go help her serve food. The menu usually consists of hot dogs, soup, crackers, cookies and coffee. Maxine spends about 12 hours each month buying, organizing and serving the food. Volunteers are enlisted to make the soup. The remaining food items are purchased. On the average, Maxine spends about 30 cents a serving!

Maxine and her husband, Harry, have been members at Jersey since 1984. They have three children and seven grandchildren.

One of Maxine’s greatest joys is helping to make sure the people around the Stowe Center do not go hungry.

Can you imagine serving over 20,400 meals to serve our Lord? We are in need of people to serve on the second Tuesday of each month. JBC is committed to serving the second Tuesday of the month in addition to the second Monday.
