### Examine Yourself - 1 Corinthians 11:17-32

#### I. The situation in Corinth. 1 Cor. 11:17-22

1. The Church was doing more harm than good. 1 Cor. 11:17
2. The Church was divided. 1 Cor. 11:18
3. The Church was inclined to excesses. 1 Cor. 11:21

***Examine yourself to see if you are making the church better or worse.***

#### II. The significance of the meal. 1 Cor. 11:23-26

1. It is a primary means to remind us that we have been reconciled.

1 Cor 11:24, Colossians 1:22

2. It is the primary means to remind us that we have been justified.

1 Cor. 11:25, Romans 5:9

***Examine yourself to see if you are mindful of being reconciled and justified because of the death of Christ.***

#### III. The seriousness of abuse. 1 Cor. 11:27-32

1. Participating in the supper in an unworthy manner is sin. 1 Cor. 11:27
2. Participating in the supper without recognizing Christ's death brings judgement. 1 Cor. 11:29

***Examine yourself to see if there is any unresolved sin or lack of focus on the death of Christ.***
