The Power of the Call



The Power of the Call - Matthew 9:35-38

Missionneering begins with a believer's eyes being open to a lost world, their hands ready to serve, and feet ready to obey God's call.

I. Missionneering involves looking outside of ourselves into eyes of hurting people. Matthew 9:36, 37

1. Their judgment is sure without Christ. Matthew 13:30
2. Their salvation is sure with Christ.

The power of God's call opens our eyes to see what we've never seen before.

II. Missionneering involves developing a plan with available resources to heal hurting people. Matthew 9:37

1. A few workers are far better than a lot of spectators.
2. With God your resources always exceed what you can see.
3. Your plans should reflect the size of the need not the availability of resources. Acts 1:8

The power of God's call opens our imagination to what is possible.

III. Missionneering involves embracing the solution God provides to help hurting people. Matthew 9:38

1. Never initiate anything you don't first saturate with prayer.
2. Delayed obedience to God's call is immediate sin. Isaiah 6:8
3. Salvation is all about grace; but someone has to work so others will know.

The power of God's call moves our feet to obedience.
