A Soldier's Salvation **Acts 10**

- I. A good soldier obeys the orders he receives from his commanding officer. Acts 10:1-8
 1. Cornelius' obedience sprung from a heart seeking God.
 2. Cornelius' obedience was immediate.

- II. A good civilian is willing to make adjustments to help soldiers and their families in a time of need. Acts 10:9-29
 1. Peter had to adjust his view of the Gentiles.
 2. Peter had to adjust his plans to travel Caesarea.

- III. A good soldier knows faith is essential to winning life's battles. Acts 10:30-48
 1. Cornelius had faith that Peter would share a word from God.
 2. Cornelius had faith in Jesus that led to victory over sin
