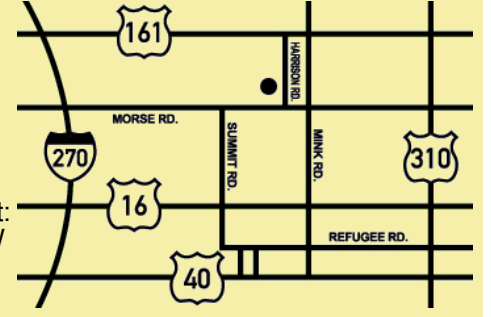

Stowe Baptist Center

Stowe Baptist Center has been meeting the needs of the inner city of Columbus for over 27 years in their present 7,500 square foot building. In 2007, Stowe served 91,608 meals through the Soup Kitchen and the Food Pantry. The present Soup Kitchen at the 911 Parsons Ave. building will seat 42 people at one time. For the last 27 years on Monday evenings, Dr. Danny Stowe, along with other Dentists and hygienists volunteer, to provide care for those who cannot afford it. The Christian Women's Job Corps also works out of Stowe Center. Volunteers from churches mentor and teach ladies who come to "restart" their lives in areas such as computer skills, interviewing for jobs and developing a relationship with Jesus Christ. Cross Town Kids will begin in October. This program is for children 7-12 years of age on Friday nights from 7:00-8:15PM. Through games, crafts and many other fun activities the children will learn about Jesus Christ.

The leadership of Stowe Center has been praying for several years about expanding to touch more lives in the inner city. In order to expand a larger facility is necessary. The building across the street became available with twice as space. Churches and individuals throughout the Metro Columbus Baptist Association are praying about what God would have them give.

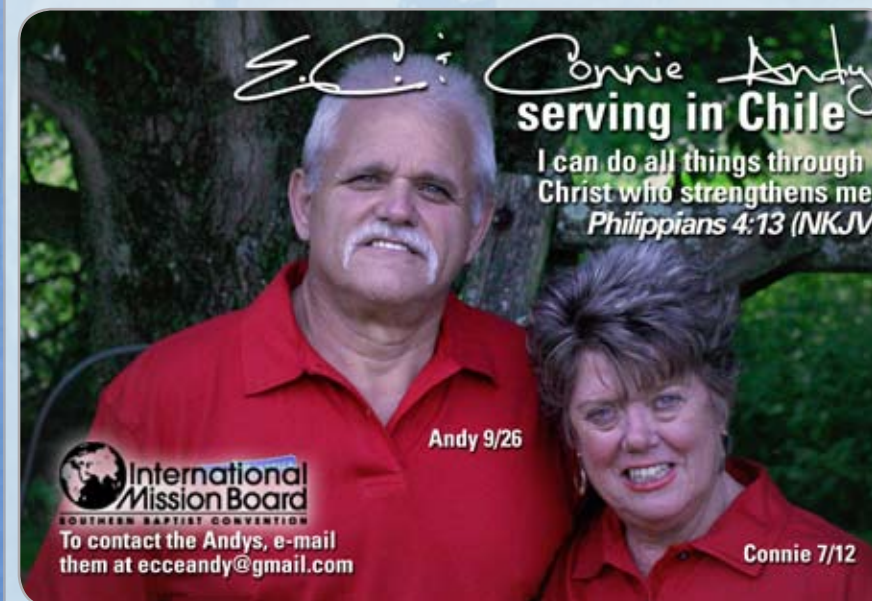
